Window and Well Options

Egress Window Wells give you an easy way out of your home and emergency personnel an entry to rescue you and your loved ones. Building codes require that finished basement living areas have an emergency egress large enough for a safe exit out of the space in case of an emergency.

What exactly is an egress window well? It's an easy-to-open basement window that serves as an emergency exit for any kind of below-ground living space. They must meet specific requirements to qualify as an egress window.

Egress windows can also help eliminate the “dungeon feeling” that many basements have as well. Egress window wells are imperative to have in case of basement flooding or in the event of a fire. Fresh air coming through the egress windows will improve your home's overall ventilation and brighten up the place.

Egress windows usually swing inward or easily slide out of the way. If there is a screen, it can be removed from the inside, making your escape quick and easy.

COVER OPTIONS

INSTALLATION STEPS

1.

Prepare the home and cover any personal belongings



2.

Excavate for the window well



3.

Measure and mark for the window location




4.
